Note: Methodology change - Before 2010, students self-identified by selecting only one option from the following categories: Hispanic/Latino, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian, Black/African American, White. As of 2010, students instead first identified themselves as to whether or not they were Hispanic/Latino, and then were able to further identify themselves in one or more of the following ethnic categories: American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian, Black/African American, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander (new), White. The results are summarized according to the following hierarchy (per federal reporting requirements):

1. Nonresident Alien, aka International Students (regardless of whether or not other categories were selected)
2. Hispanic/Latino (regardless of whether or not other categories were selected)
3. Each of the five ethnic categories (if only one was chosen)...

NOTE: ERLI students are excluded from all counts. Exchange, escrow, and readmitted students are included in the "all students" counts but are excluded from the "new student" counts. New students are comprised of First-time, Transfer, and Nondegree students who were enrolled in the fall term and first enrolled either that fall or the immediately preceding summer (session A, B, or C). Figures prior to 2014 represent a slightly different definition for new students, in two ways: (1) Readmitted students were previously included in the new student count, and (2) students who began in Summer A or C were previously excluded from the new student count.
