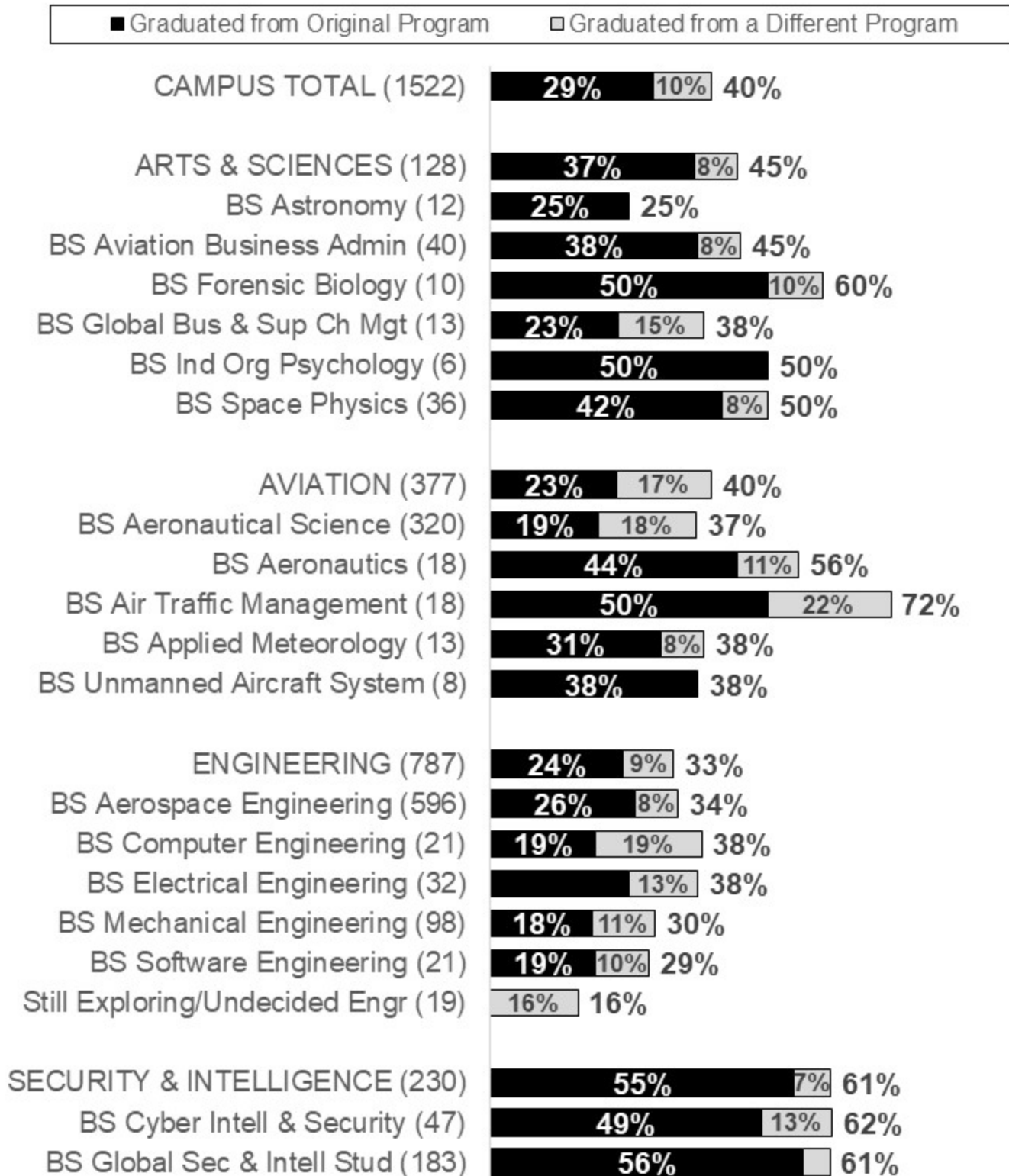


Average Four-Year Graduation Rates: By Original Degree Program
