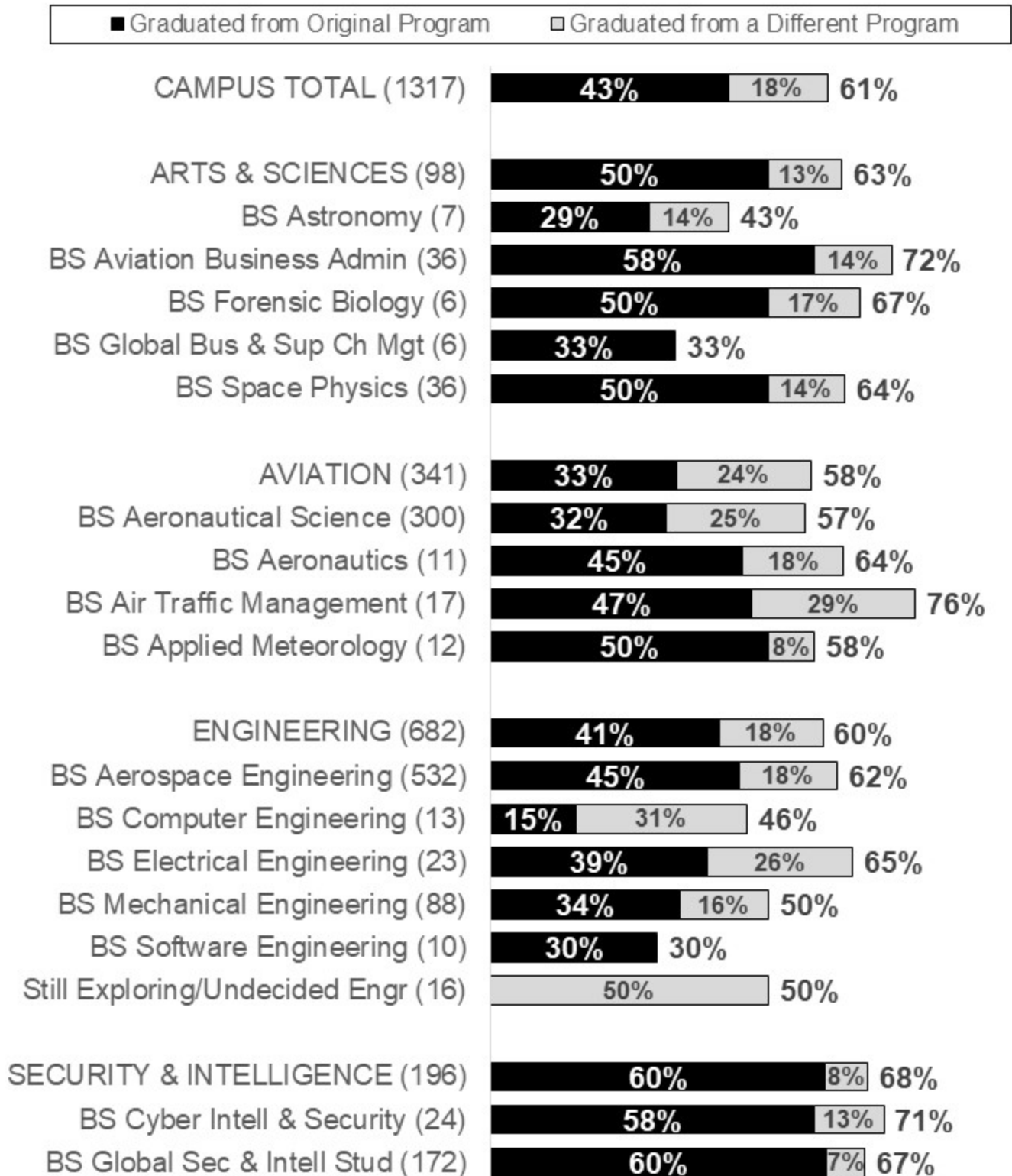


Average Five-Year Graduation Rates: By Original Degree Program
