Overall figures for unduplicated headcount (each student counted once, regardless if they are currently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program) are presented in this fact sheet. The Fall 2008 undergraduate enrollment of 4,657 at Daytona Beach is a 1.6% increase since Fall 2007, while the undergraduate enrollment of 1,688 at Prescott is a 1% increase. The Daytona Beach on-campus graduate enrollment of 344 is a 1.5% increase since last year, while the online graduate enrollment of 61 is an increase of 10.9%. Prescott's graduate enrollment of 31 is the same as last year. At Daytona Beach, there were 1,385 new undergraduates (a 6.1% increase from last year), and at Prescott, there were 546 new undergraduates (a 6.6% increase from last year).
