Overall figures for unduplicated headcount are presented in this fact sheet. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program. Since Fall 2010, Daytona Beach's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 2.2% (from 4,496 to 4597), while new undergraduates increased 2% (from 1288 to 1313). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 1.1% (from 1,654 to 1,672), while new undergraduates decreased 6% (from 500 to 470). The graduate enrollment at Daytona Beach has increased by 2.5% (from 593 to 608), while Prescott's graduate enrollment stayed constant at 51.
