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Overall figures for unduplicated headcount are presented in this fact sheet. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program. Since last fall, Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by .4% (from 1672 to 1678), while new undergraduates increased 3.4% (from 470 to 486). Daytona Beach's undergraduate enrollment has decreased by 1.4% (from 4597 to 4534), while new undergraduates decreased 6.4% (from 1313 to 1229). The graduate enrollment at Daytona Beach has decreased by 3.6% (from 608 to 586), while Prescott's graduate enrollment decreased 9.8% (from 51 to 46).
