

# ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The Official Fall 2015 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on September 14th and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session.

Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has increased by 6.3% (from 4,967 to 5,278) and graduate enrollment has decreased by 7.5% (from 571 to 528). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 11.1% (from 1,984 to 2,205) and graduate enrollment has increased by 17.6% (from 51 to 60).
