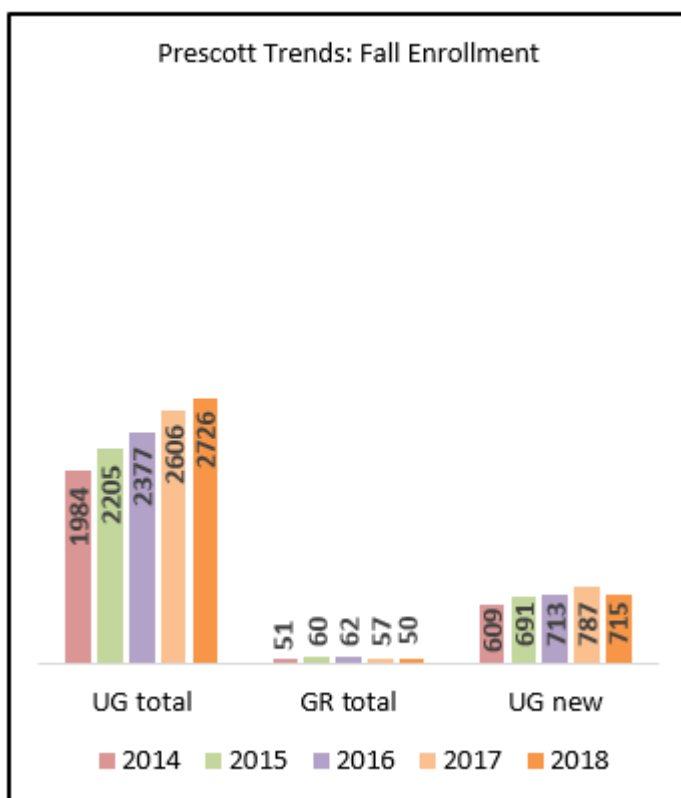
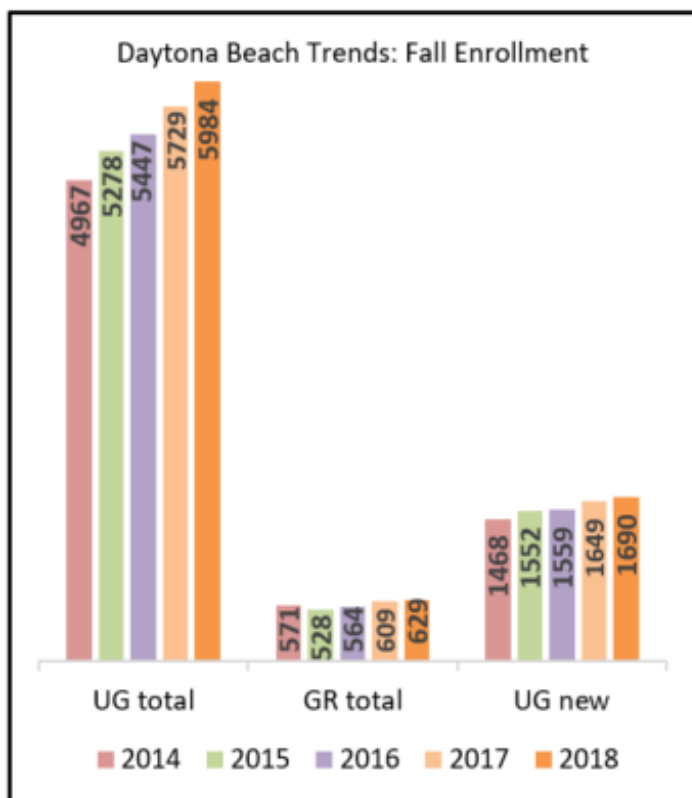


ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official Fall 2018 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on September 17th and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last fall, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has increased by 4.3% (from 5,729 to 5984) and graduate enrollment has increased by 3.2% (from 609 to 629). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 4.4% (from 2,606 to 2726) and graduate enrollment has decreased by 12.3% (from 57 to 50).
