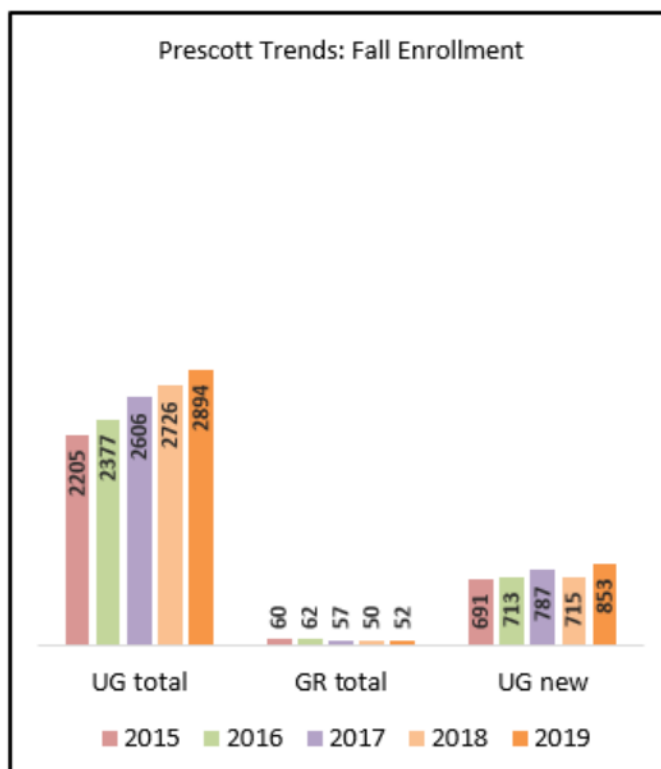
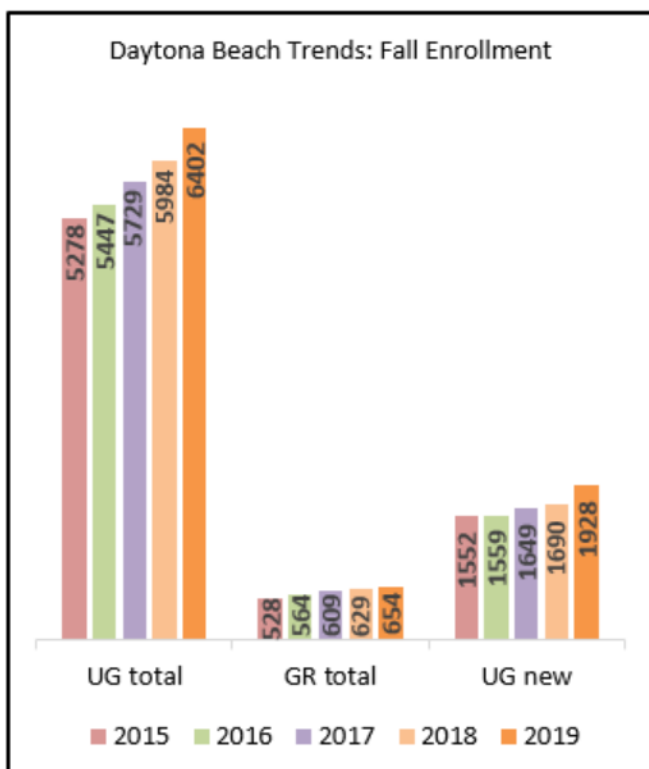


ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official Fall 2019 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on September 16th and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last fall, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has increased by 7% (from 5984 to 6402) and graduate enrollment has increased by 4% (from 629 to 654). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 6.2% (from 2,726 to 2894) and graduate enrollment has increased by 4% (from 50 to 52).
