

ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official Summer A 2019 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on May 28th and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last Summer A, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has decreased by 3.50% (from 1,370 to 1,322) and graduate enrollment has increased by 23% (from 77 to 100). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 1.8% (from 491 to 500) and graduate enrollment has decreased by 69.23% (from 13 to 4).
