

# ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official Summer B 2018 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on July 16<sup>th</sup> and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last Summer B, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has decreased by 1.28% (from 1,158 to 1,173) and graduate enrollment has decreased by 26.56% (from 64 to 47). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has decreased by 4.05% (from 332 to 346) and graduate enrollment has decreased by 40.0% (from 10 to 6).
