

# ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official Summer C 2019 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on May 28<sup>th</sup> and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last Summer C, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has increased by 0.86% (from 1,270 to 1,281) and graduate enrollment has increased by .99% (from 200 to 202). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 8.71% (from 505 to 461) and graduate enrollment has increased by 28.57% (from 7 to 5).
