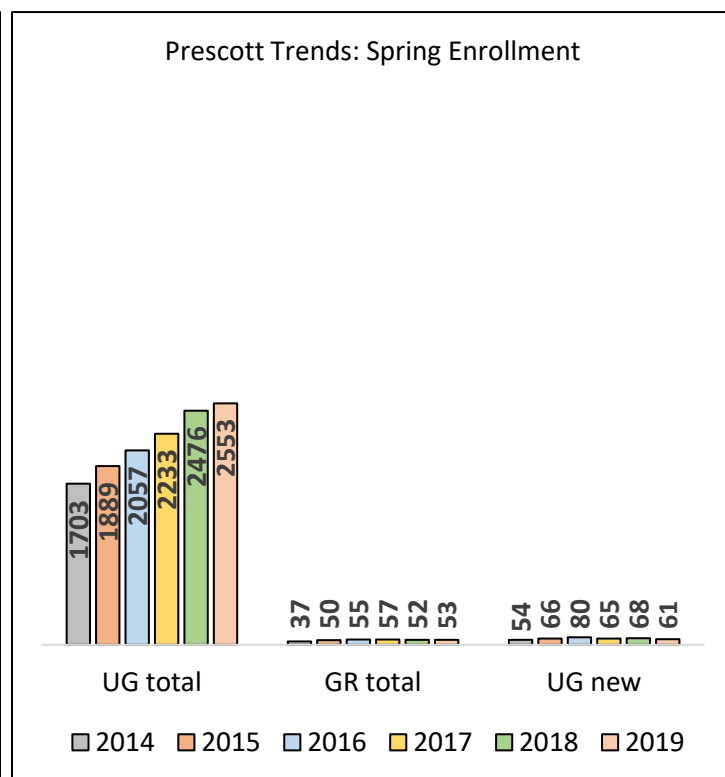
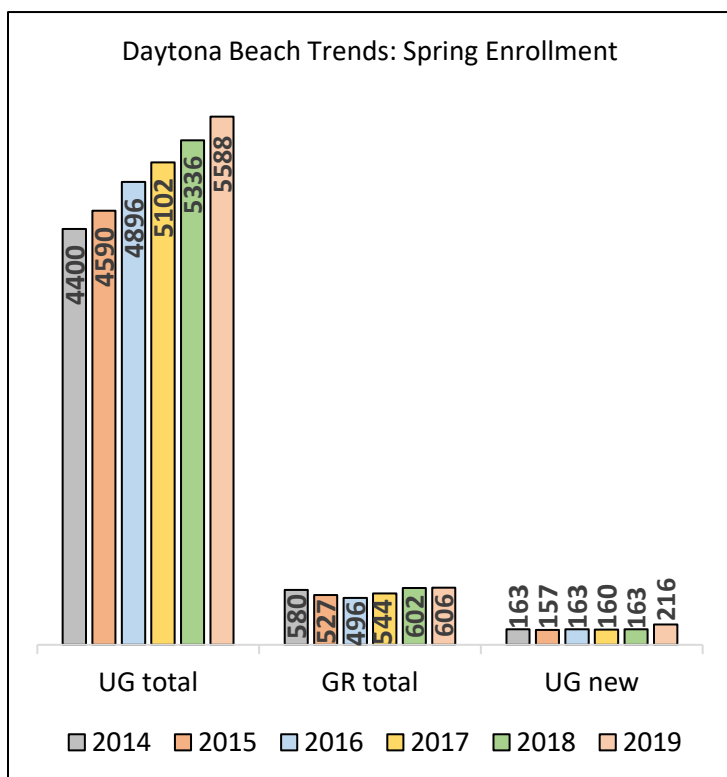


ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official spring 2019 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on January 30th and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last spring, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has increased by 4.51% (from 5,336 to 5588) and graduate enrollment has increased by .66% (from 602 to 606). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 3.02% (from 2,476 to 2553) and graduate enrollment has increased by 1.89% (from 52 to 53).
