

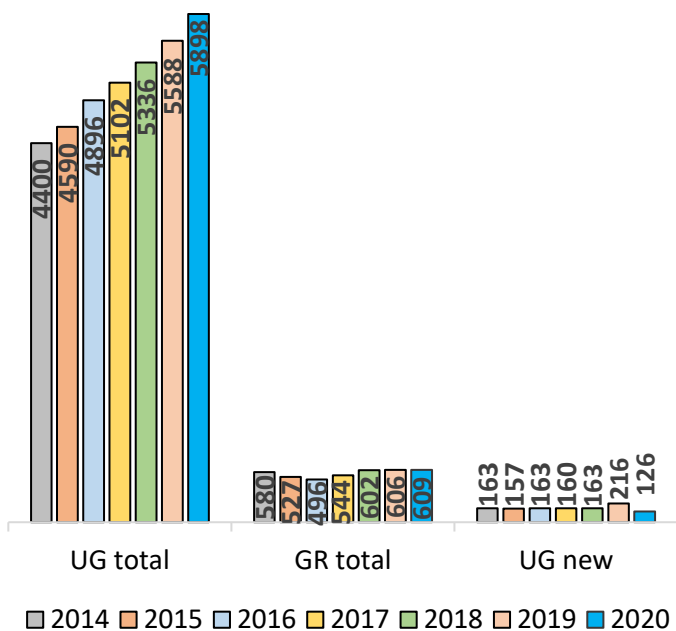
# ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official spring 2020 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on January 29<sup>th</sup> and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last spring, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has increased by 5.25% (from 5588 to 5898) and graduate enrollment has increased by .05% (from 606 to 609). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 7.16% (from 2553 to 2750) and graduate enrollment has decreased by 7.54% (from 53 to 49).

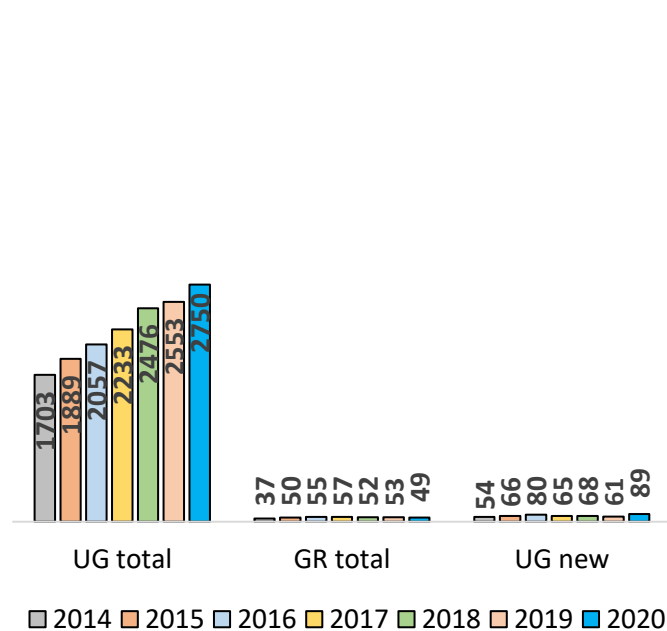
