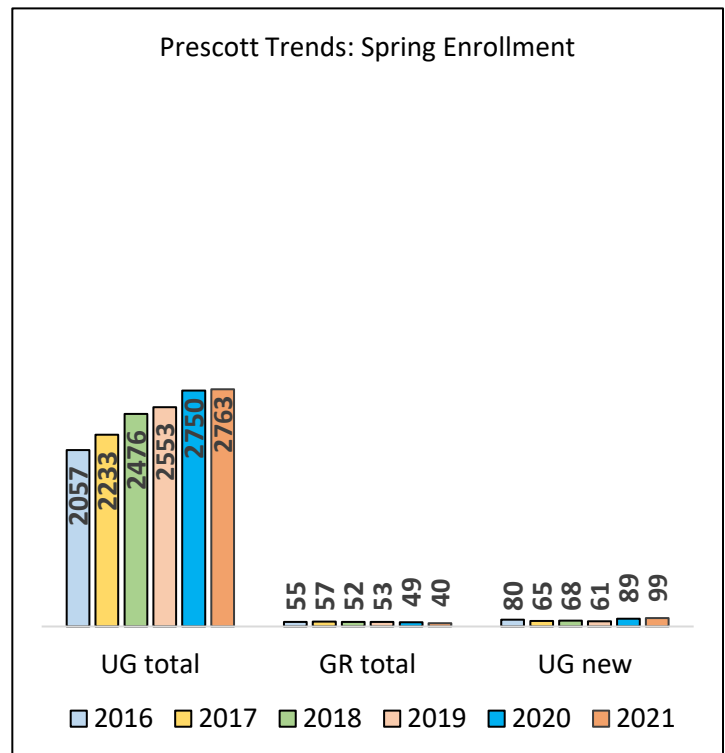
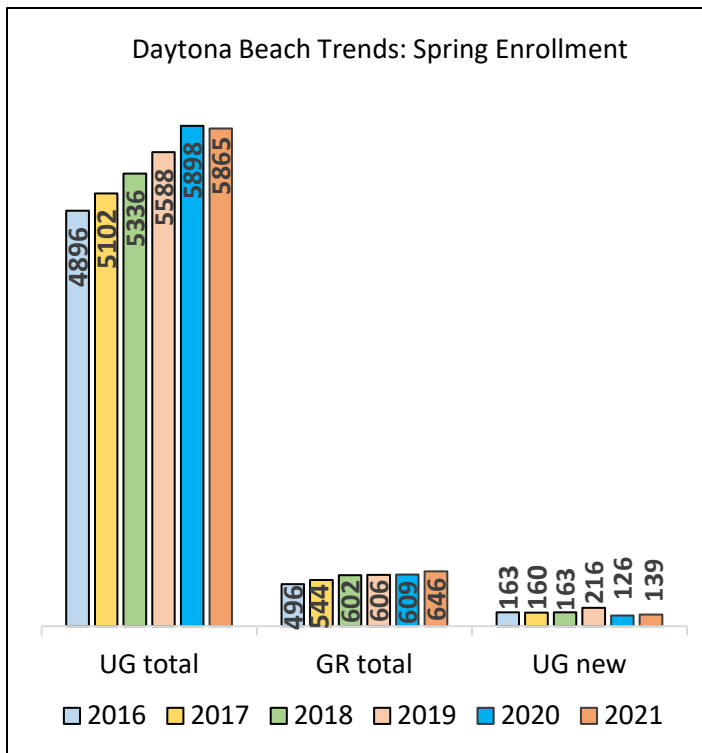


ENROLLMENT FACT SHEET

The official spring 2021 enrollment captured below is as of the close of business on February 10th and reflects an unduplicated headcount. Each student is counted only once, even if concurrently enrolled in both an undergraduate and graduate program during that session. Since last spring, Daytona Beach undergraduate enrollment has decreased by 0.56% (from 5898 to 5865) and graduate enrollment has increased by 5.90% (from 609 to 646). Prescott's undergraduate enrollment has increased by 0.47% (from 2750 to 2763) and graduate enrollment has decreased by 20.22% (from 49 to 40).
