As of 2010, students instead first identified themselves as Hispanic/Latino or not, then as one or more of the following: American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian, Black/African American, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander (new), White. The results are summarized according to the following hierarchy (per federal reporting requirements):

1. Nonresident Alien, aka International Students (regardless of whether or not other categories were selected)
2. Hispanic/Latino (regardless of whether or not other categories were selected)
3. Each of the five ethnic categories (if only one was chosen)
4. Two or more races (if more than one of the five individual categories was chosen)

2013-2017 breakouts are revised since originally reported, due to an internal system calculation error in place at the time (primarily affected the Hispanic/Latino, Two or More, and Unknown results).

Excludes ERLI and Gaetz Academy students. New students = Fall enrolled 1st-time, Transfer, and Non Degree students who began that fall or summer. Excludes exchange students. Definition pre-2014: readmits were included, Sum A/C starters were excluded.
