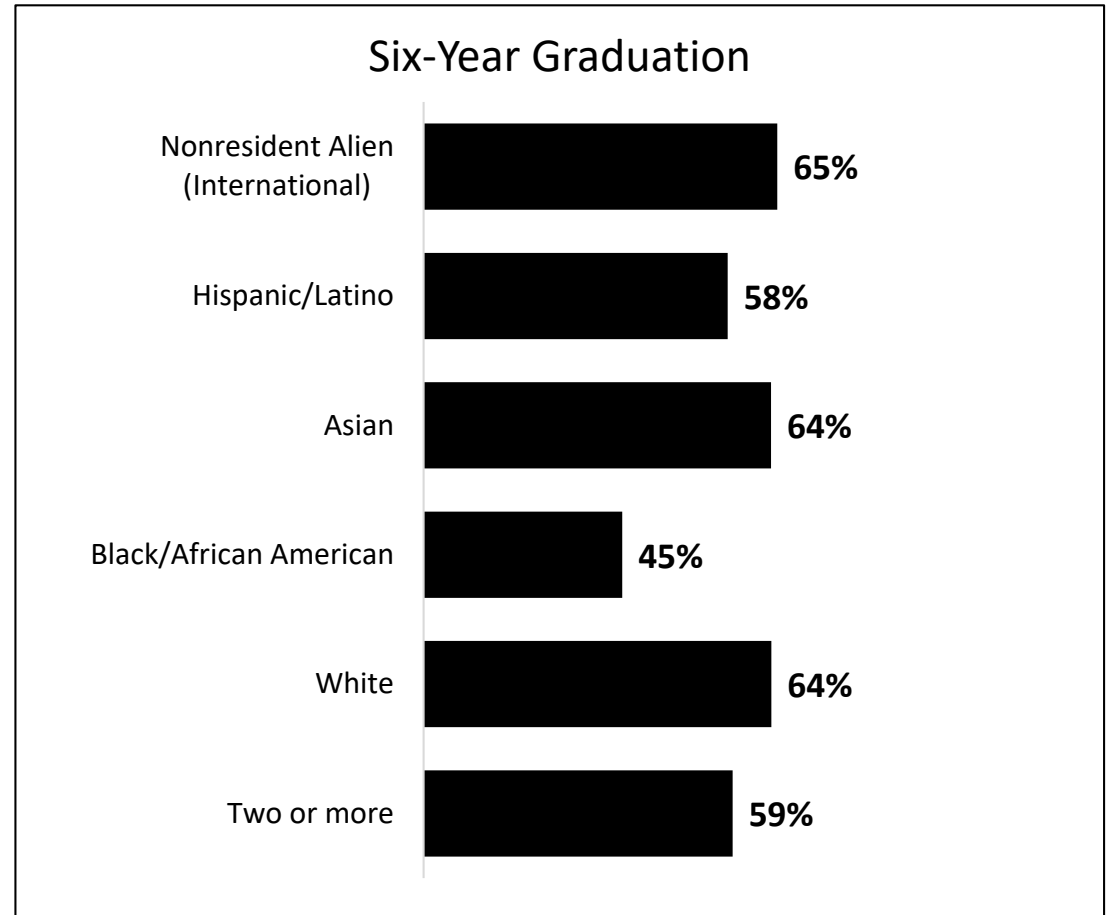
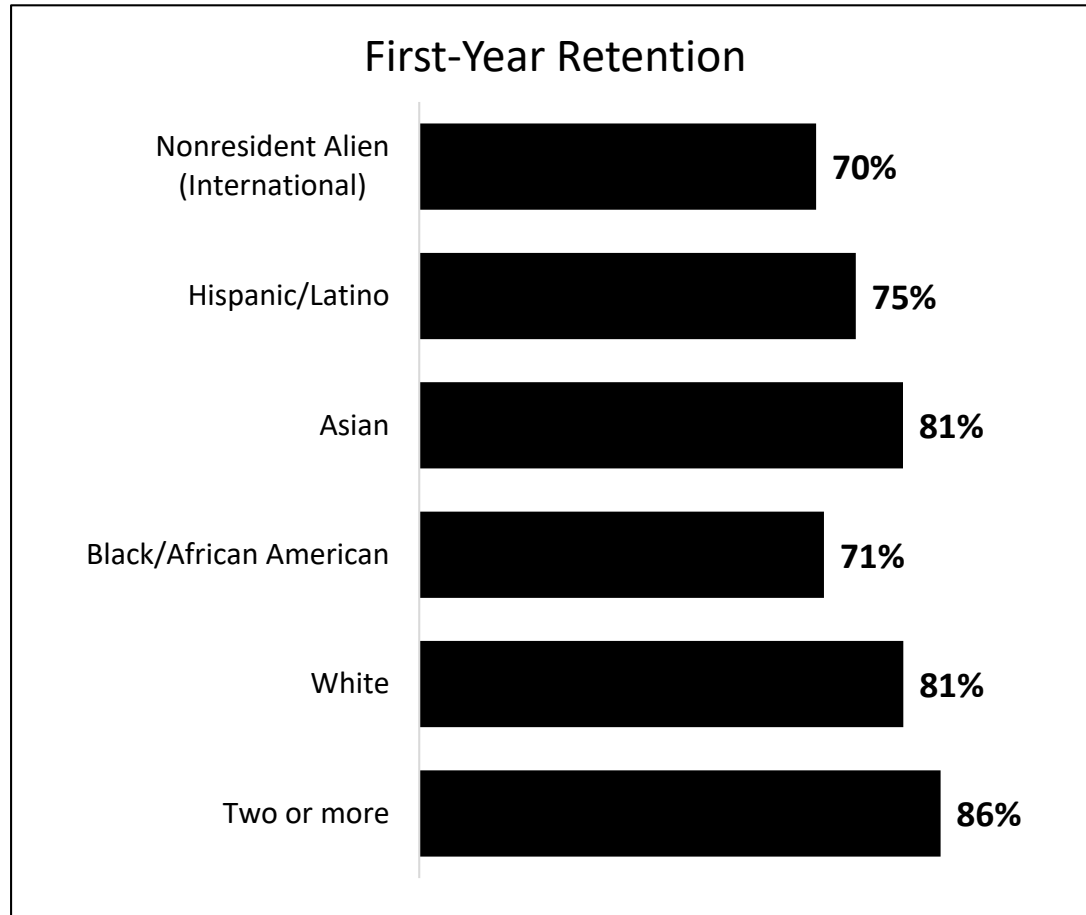


# Average First-Year Retention and Six-Year Graduation Rates: By Ethnicity Daytona Beach
