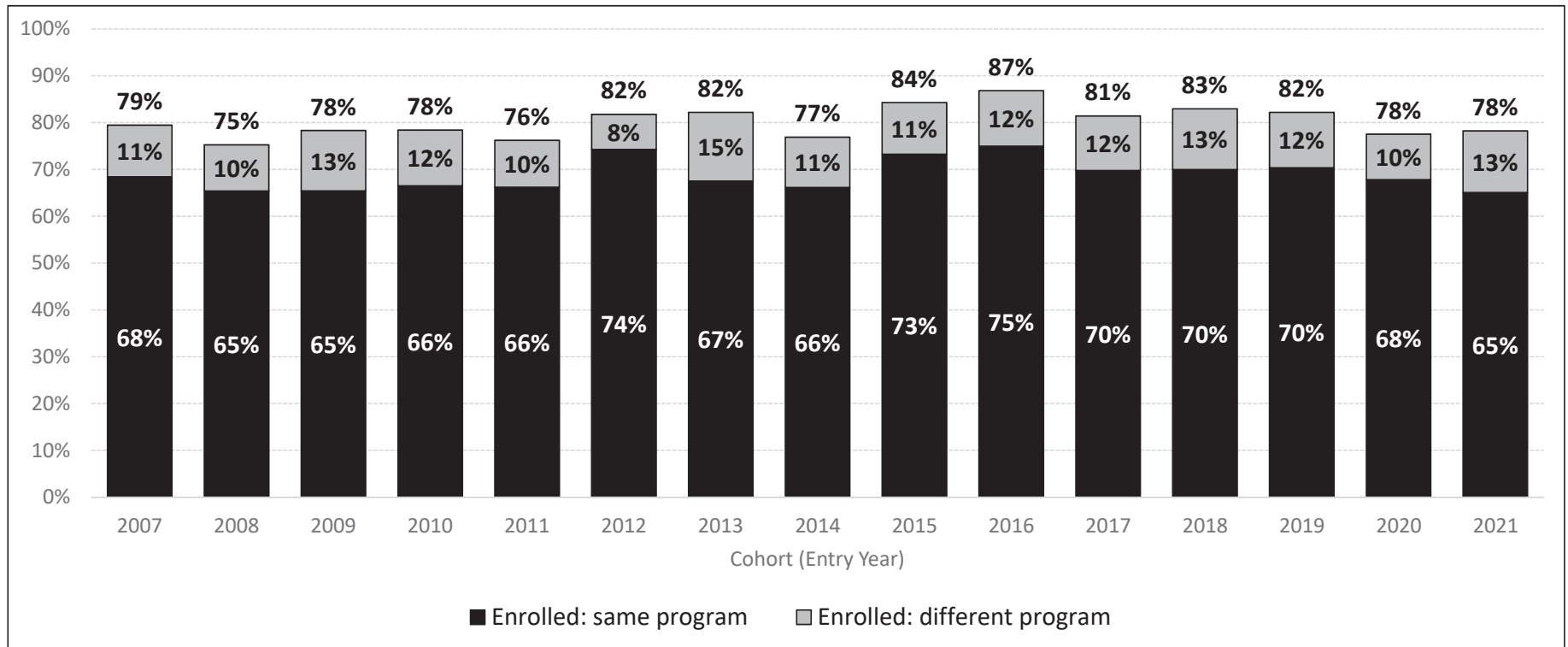


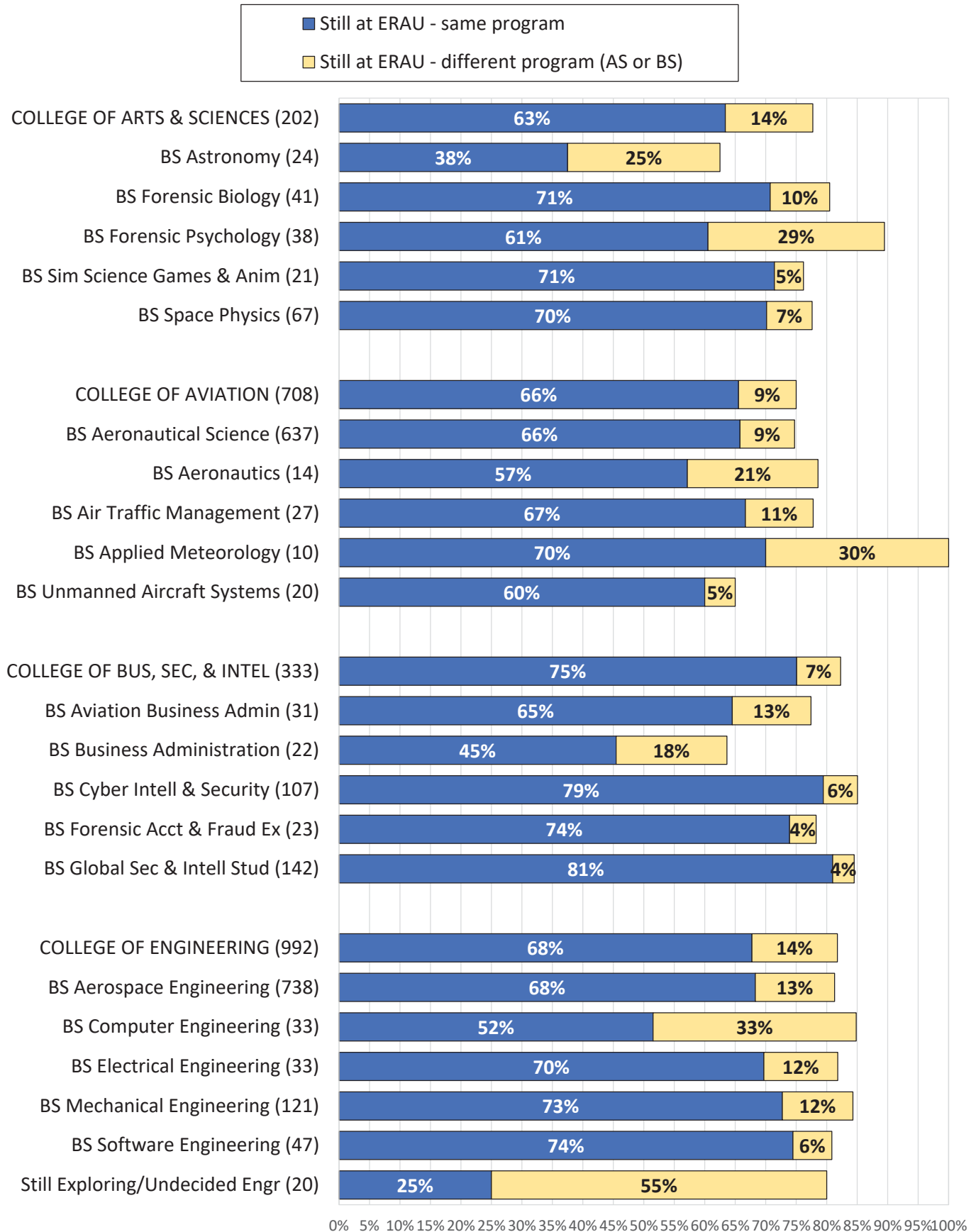
ERAU and Within-Program First-Year Retention Rates: Overall Prescott

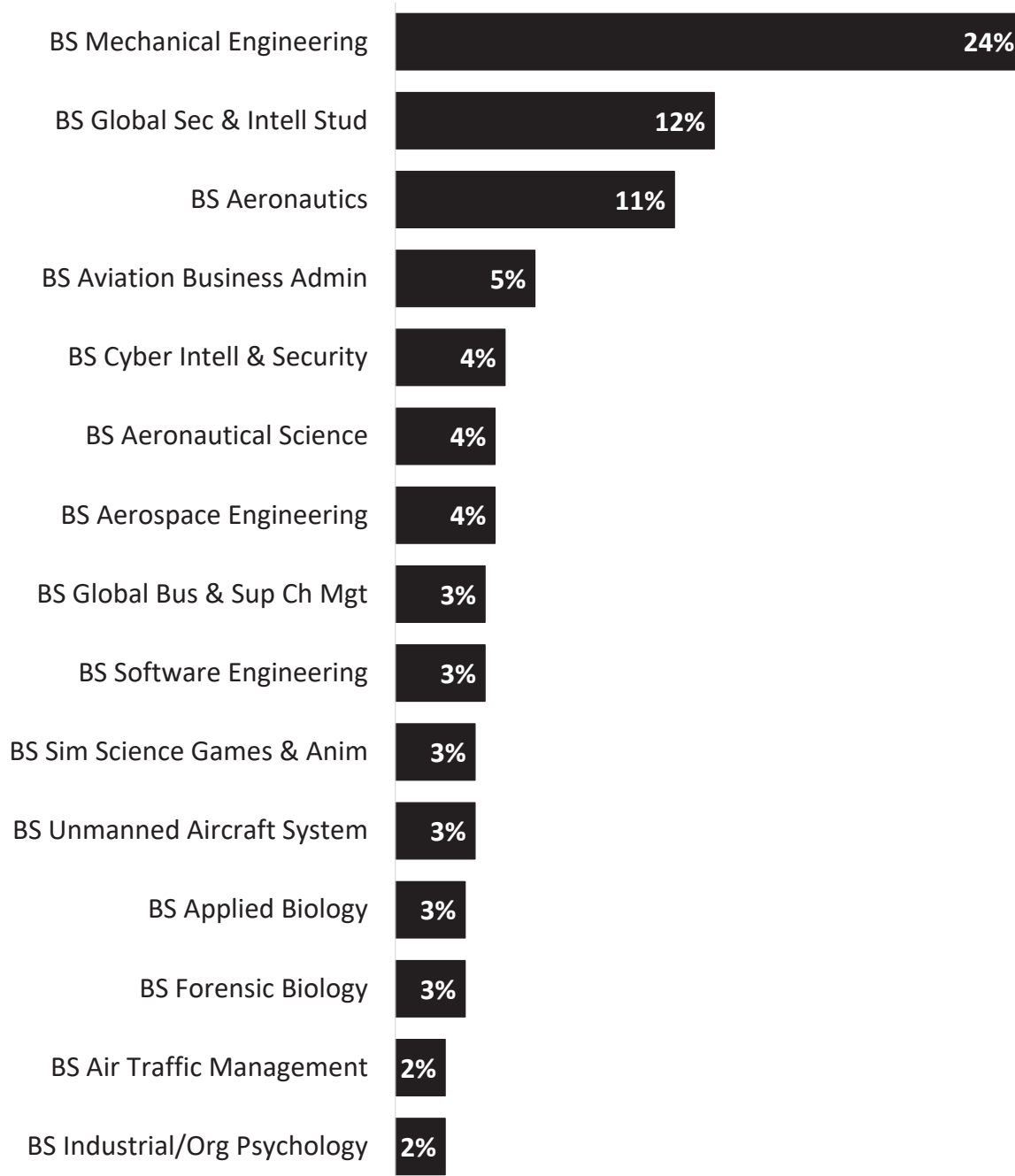
