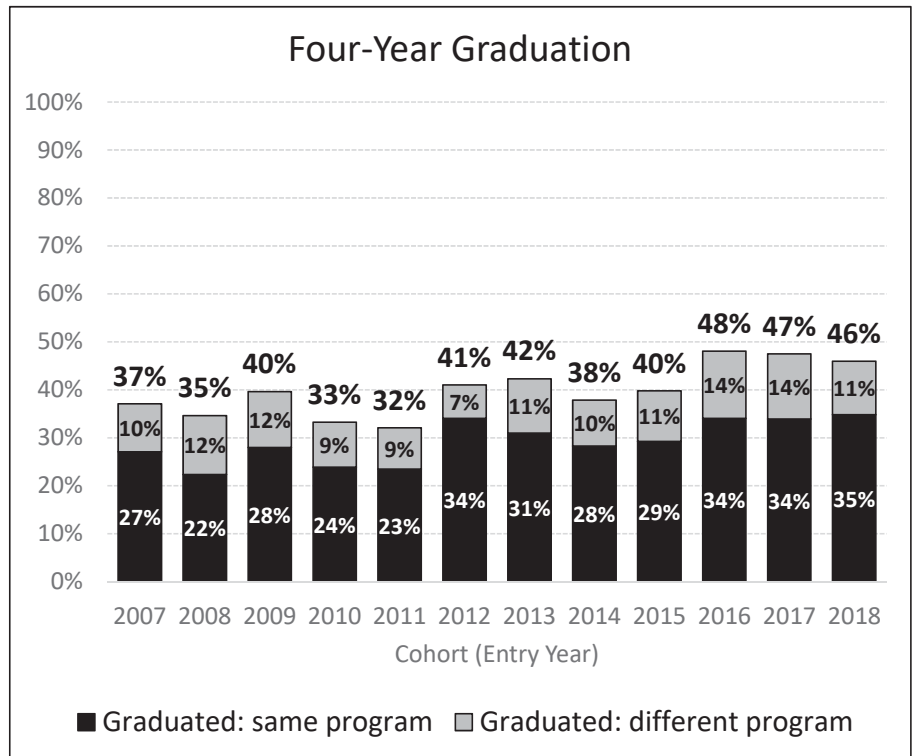
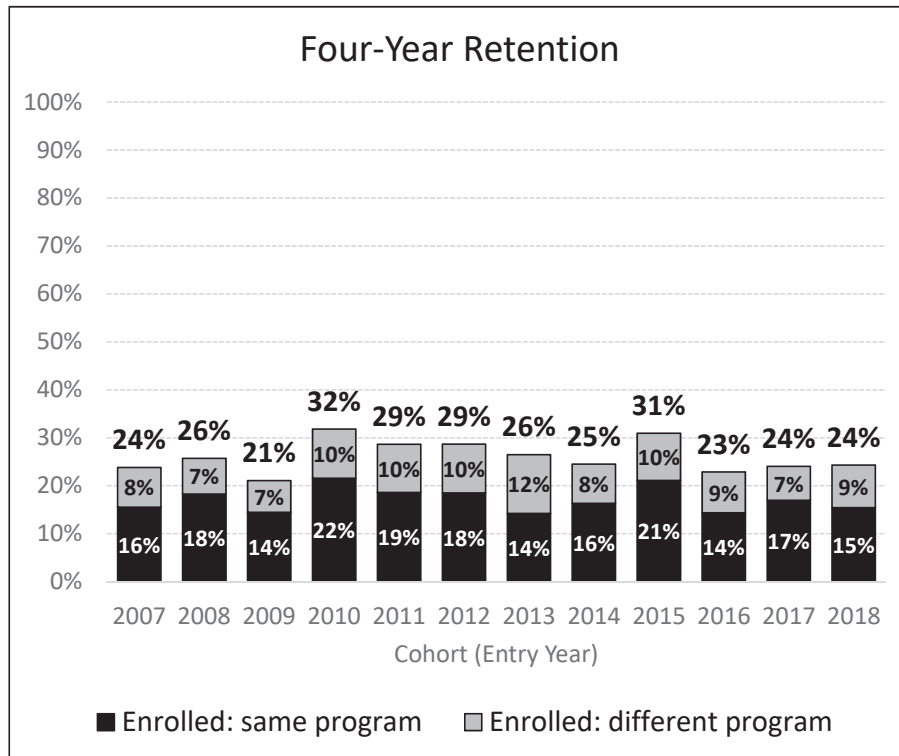


## ERAU and Within-Program Four-Year Retention & Graduation Rates: Overall Prescott

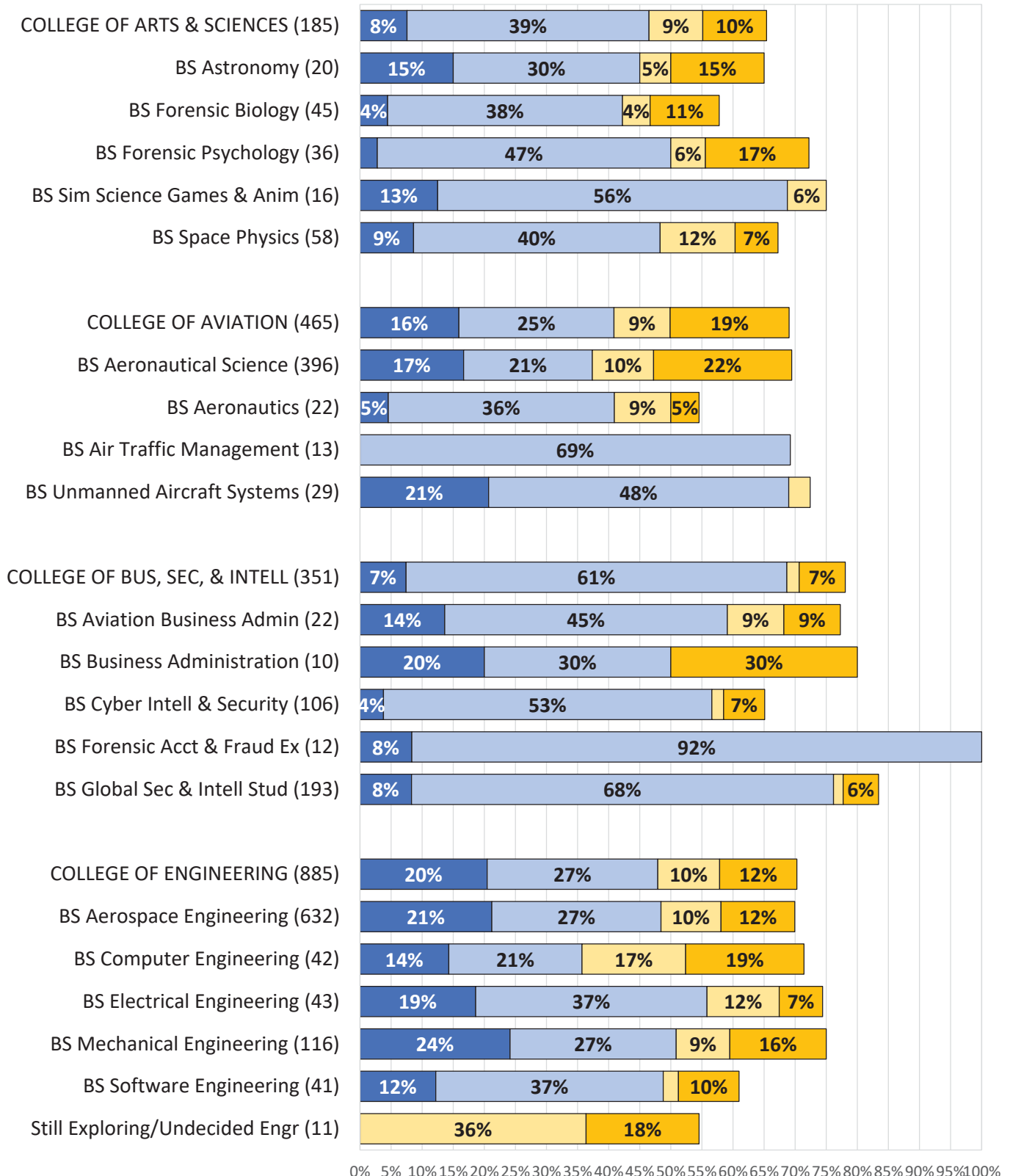
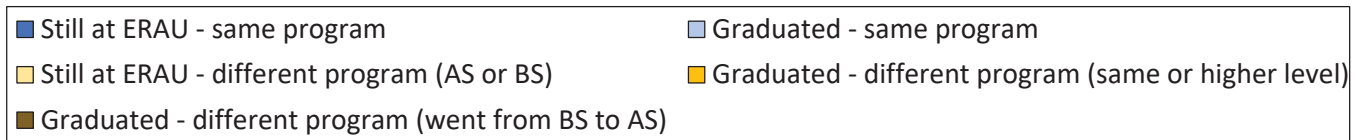

## Average Program Migration After Four Years: by Program at Entry (average = three most recent cohorts (2018, 2017, 2016) combined)

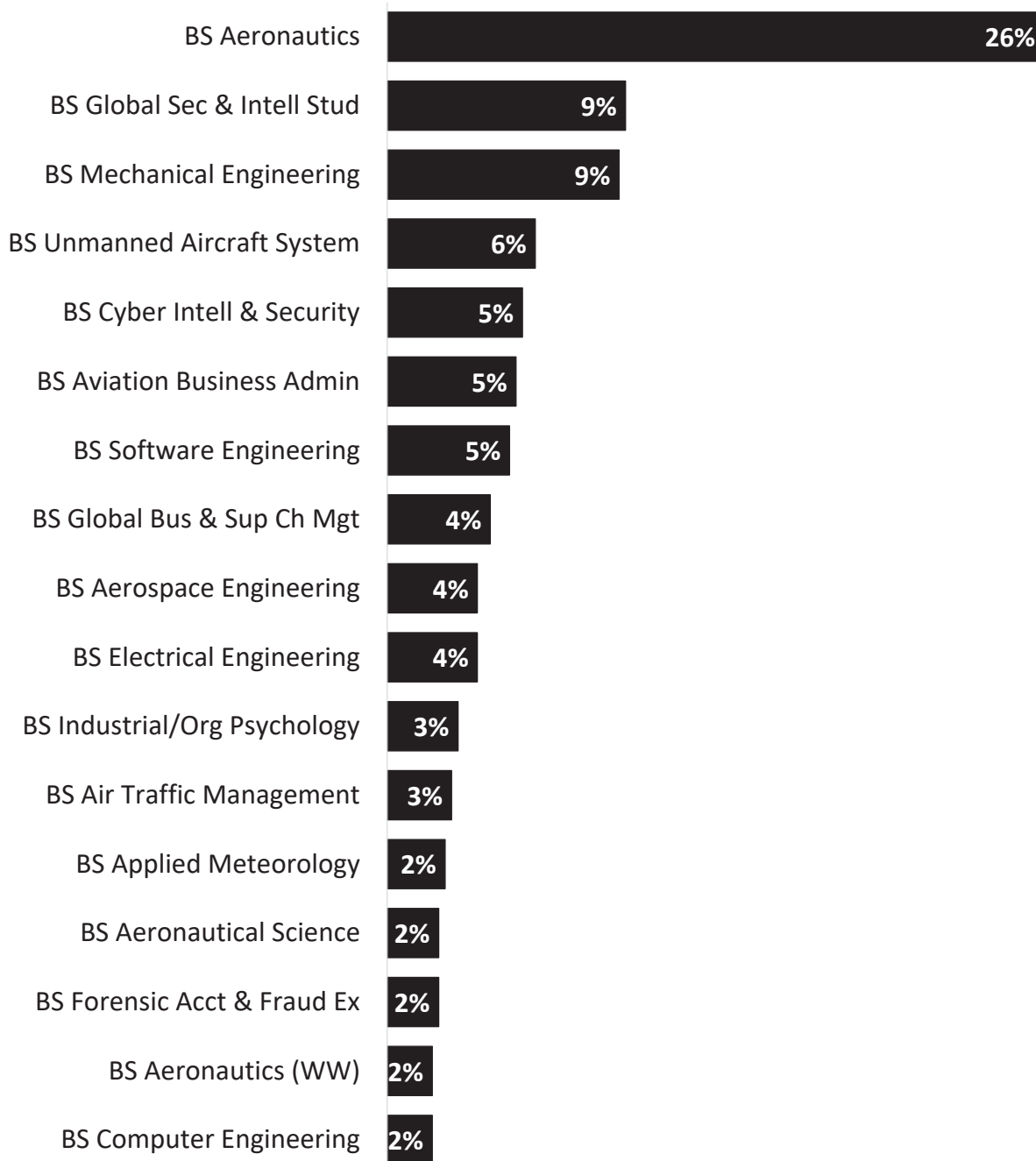
