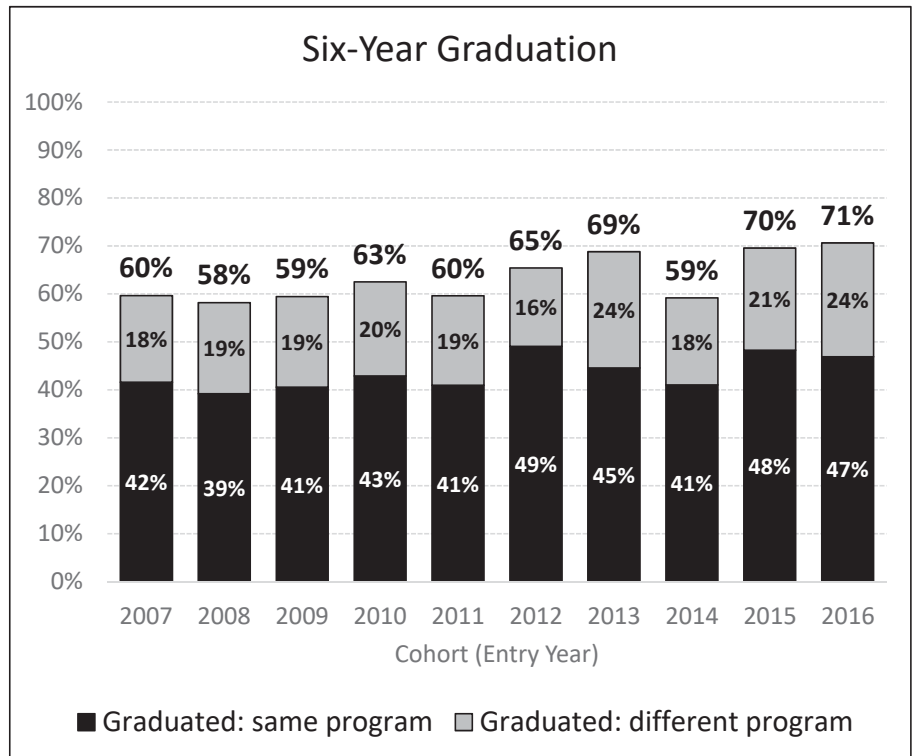
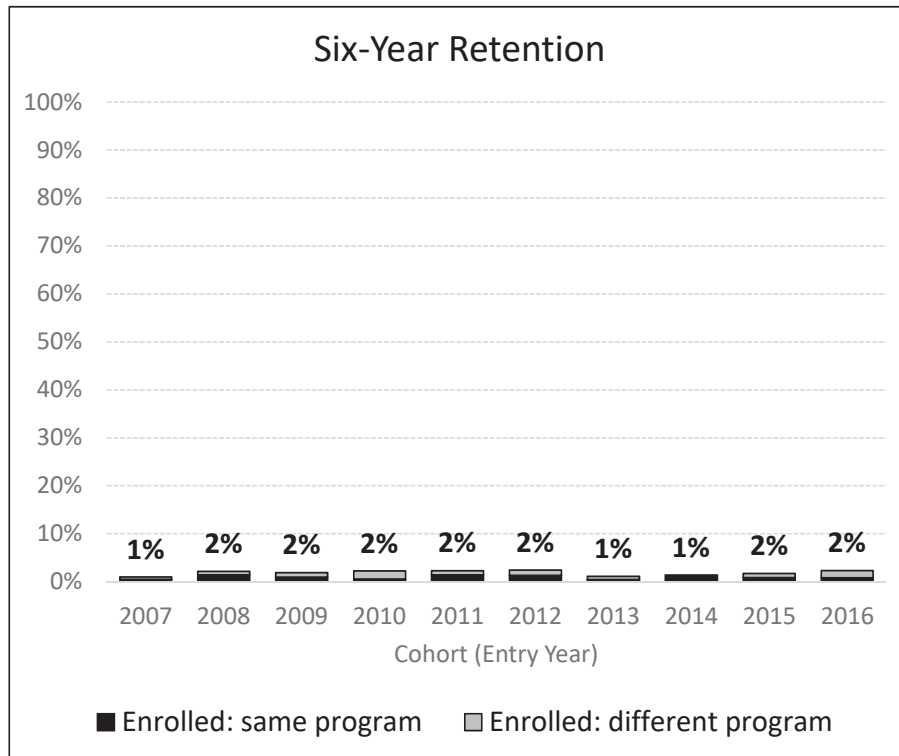


## ERAU and Within-Program Six-Year Retention & Graduation Rates: Overall Prescott

Graduation = Obtained a BS degree from DB, PC, or WW. Graduation rates are cumulative (all students who graduated up to that point).

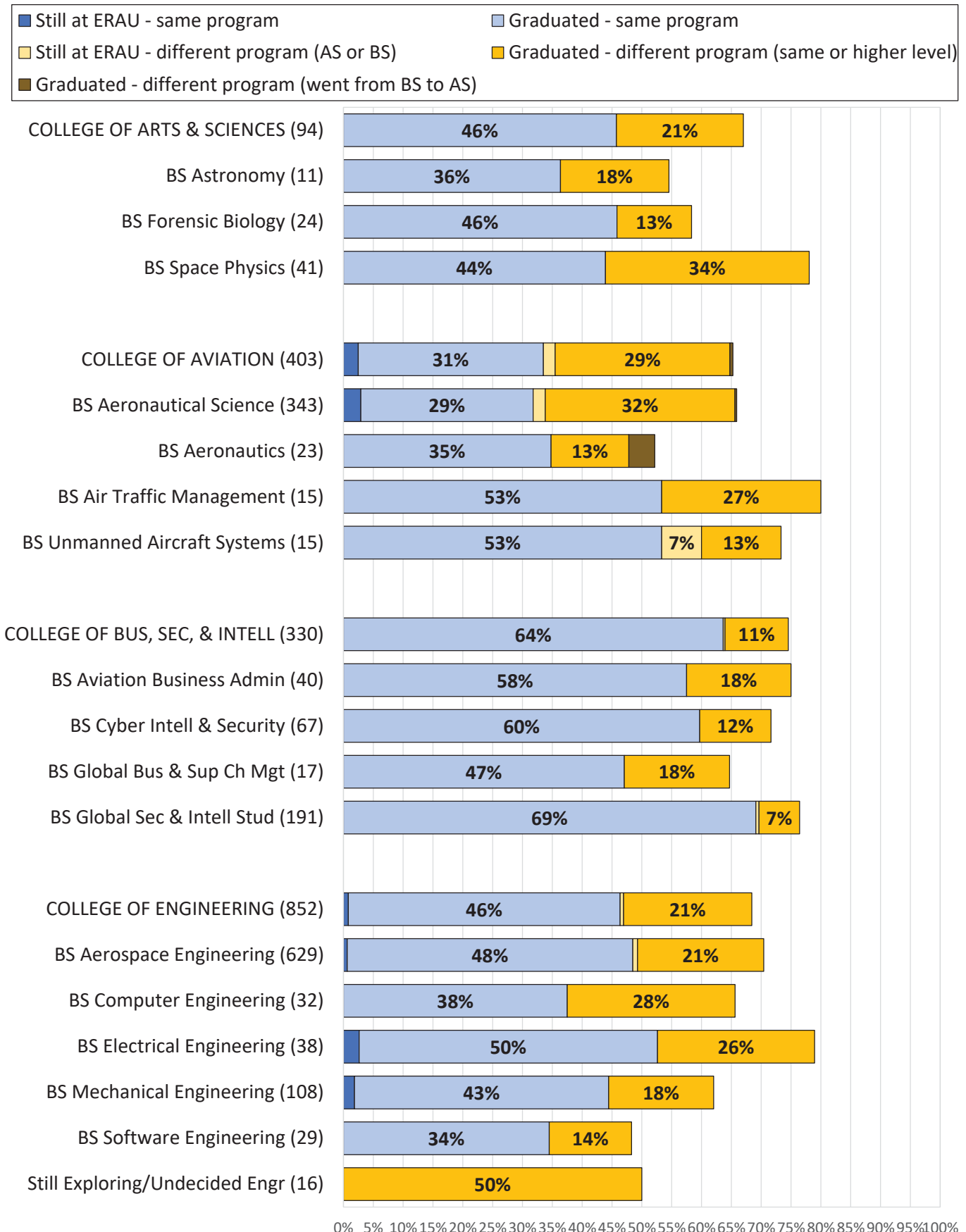

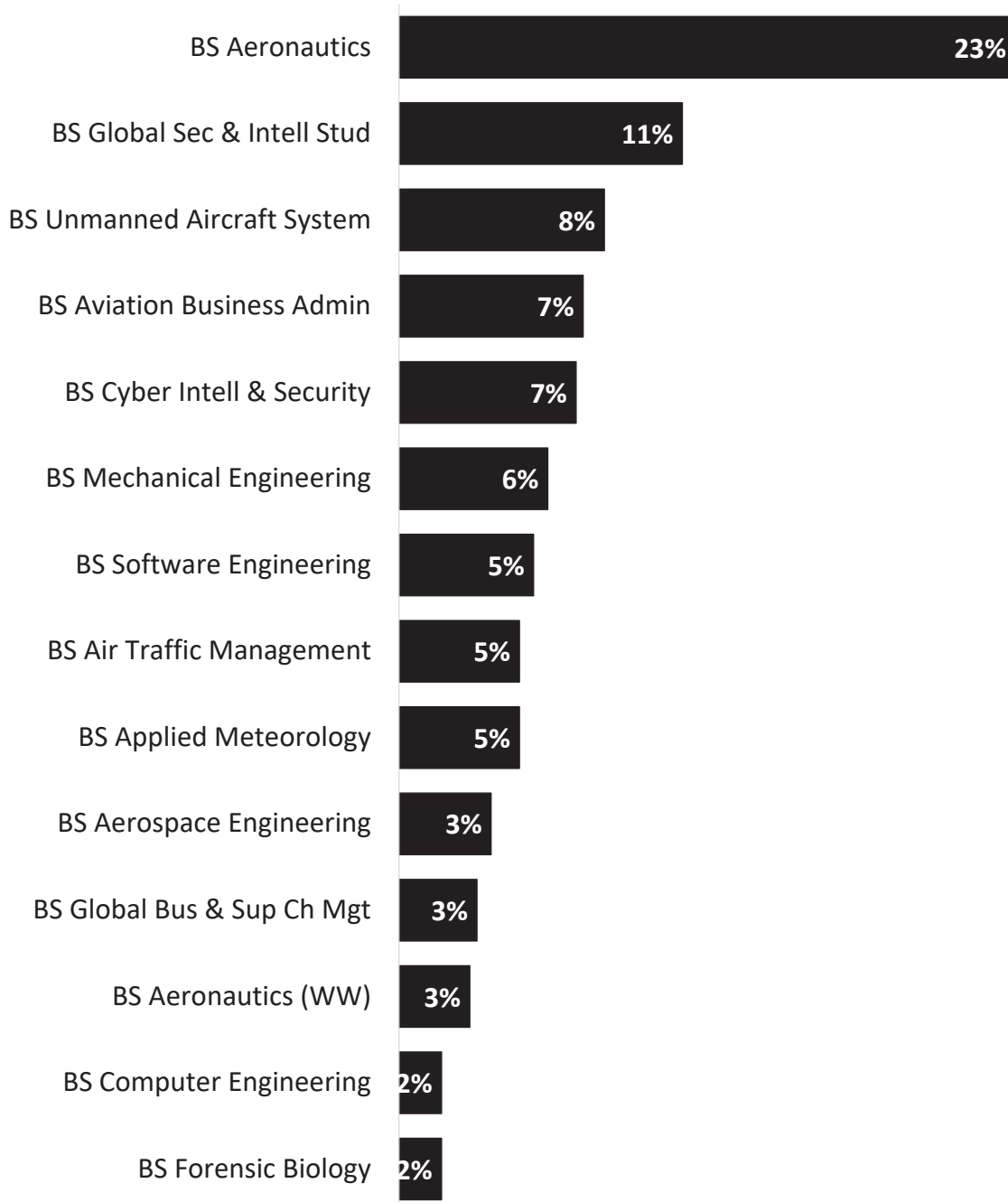
## Average Program Migration After Six Years: by Program at Entry (average = three most recent cohorts (2016, 2015, 2014) combined)

The intended use of this matrix is to broadly explore average migration patterns between programs for a very specific subset of students (an aggregate of the three most recent cohorts) at specific snapshots (entry vs the noted time interval). As such, these results are best interpreted by how they compare in relation to each other, rather than the explicit value of the figure itself.
